With a new system in place for code distribution, and a protocol for dealing with the cleaning, etc. involved with COVID-19, we are now ready to reopen: this Monday. To mark the re-opening, we will hold an hour of Eucharistic adoration in Glastonbury Hall, following this Monday morning's Mass. The chapel will reopen at 10:30 am.
