**THE FRIENDS OF ST. ANDREW'S CHAPEL** has produced a video on Bishop MacEachern which is available on You Tube under "Bishop Angus Bernard MacEachern PEI." This 33-minute-long video concerns his life as a missionary priest on the Island and as the first bishop of the Diocese of Charlottetown. It narrates the difficulties he encountered and the steps took to overcome them. At the beginning there was not only the need for the creation of parishes, but the need for the education of clergy to see to the needs of the Island. Later this developed to the sending of clergy to other missions off the Island. Higher education for the laity was also initiated to create community leaders. It is hoped that this video is found to be entertaining, instructive, and inspiring.
