A REMINDER OF PUBLIC HEALTH PROTOCOLS: Physical distancing, hand-sanitizing, mask-wearing while moving about and while singing, and staying home if feeling unwell or are required to be in self-isolation.

UPDATE: Word has been received this week from Public Health through the Diocese that, effective immediately, while staying in place at the seat—sitting, standing, kneeling—mask-wearing is no longer required. Masks remain required while entering, leaving, singing, and, as before, in the Communion line.
