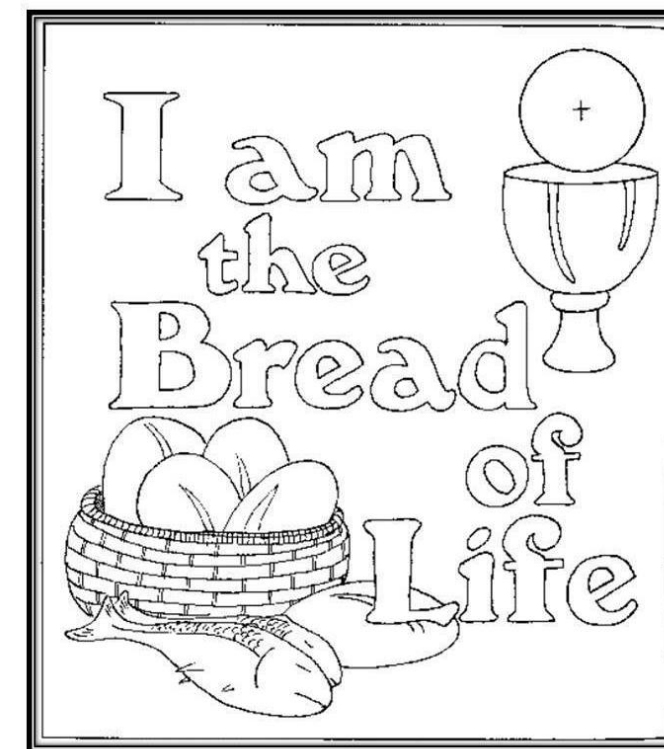

CONNOLLY ESTATE BUSARIES are open to residents of PEI who are *full-time students enrolled in an undergraduate program at an accredited university*. In addition, applicants must demonstrate that they are *Roman Catholic*, are *Irish in heritage* and have *material financial need* (parental income applies if applicant is under 22). College students who are completing a joint program/degree must be enrolled in the university portion of their studies to be eligible. Apply at www.owenconnollyestate.com by end of day August 31st. The online application will be available the first of July. Recent bursaries have been in the range of \$2,000/year, though they vary depending on market returns and the number of applicants. Bursaries are available for a maximum of four years.
