It is with profound sadness that I write to you.

On October 31st, Fr. Maurice Praught was arrested and will be facing charges of sexual exploitation and sexual assault. He has since “been released from custody pending a court date in December” (Summerside Police press release.)

Fr. Chris Sherren has been designated as the spokesperson for the diocese regarding this matter. He will be the contact person for the media, press and all related inquiries.

I implore your prayers for the victim, the priest against whom charges have been brought, and all who are affected in any way.
