CONNOLLY ESTATE BURSARY APPLICATIONS: Connolly Estate bursaries are open to residents of PEI who can demonstrate that they are Roman Catholic, are Irish in heritage, and have material financial need. Applicants must be full-time students enrolled in an undergraduate program at an accredited university. College students who are completing a joint program / degree must be enrolled in the university portion of their studies to be eligible. You must apply at www.OwenConnollyestate.com before end of day August 31, 2024. If, as of August 31, 2024:

- a. You are under age 22, the applicant and parent's income shall be used to assess financial need;
 - b. You are over age 22, the applicant and spouse's income shall be used to assess financial need.
- Recent bursaries have been in the \$2,000 range but vary depending on investment returns and number of successful applicants. Successful applicants will be notified on December 15, 2024.
